Wolfwalkers by Tomm Moore & Ross Stewart (Melusine Productions) is nominated for Best Animated Picture at the 74th BAFTA's - British Academy Film Awards (to be held on 11 April) and at the 93rd Academy Awards - Oscars (to be held on 25 April).
