Bad Luck Banging or Loony Porn by Radu Jude (Paul Thiltges Distributions) won the Golden Bear at the *71st Berlin International Film Festival*.

<u>Wolfwalkers</u> by Tomm Moore & Ross Stewart (Melusine Productions) is nominated for Best Animated Picture at the 74th *BAFTA's - British Academy Film Awards* (to be held on 11 April) and at the 93rd Academy Awards - Oscars (to be held on 25 April).

<u>Collective</u> by Alexander Nanau (Samsa Film) is nominated for Best Documentary at the *BAFTA*'s and for two *Academy Awards* - *Oscars* in the categories: Best Documentary Feature Film and Best International Feature Film.
